Student support in Italy: how does it work?

Students in **disadvantaged economic conditions** who satisfy specific criteria of merit may be eligible for a **GRANT**.

The **economic condition** is assessed through an indicator called the **Economic Status Index** which considers the student's family savings, plus 20% of their real income.

The **students' merit** is assessed by the number of credits obtained in the first year of enrolment: i.e. newly-enrolled students must have 25 credits to receive a grant in the second academic year and 30 credits for the third year.

Eligible off-campus students can ask for a room in a hall of residence.

Students receiving the grant do not pay any tuition fees.
